In geography we will be looking at where we live. We will study the geography of our school and of Brayton. We will use aerial maps to study the key human and physical features. We will also look at seasonal and daily weather patterns in Brayton.

In science we will be looking at the human body, naming, drawing and labelling basic parts. We will particularly look at which part of the body is linked to each of the five senses. We will be carrying out investigations linked to this topic.

In history, we will be looking at toys, starting with our own favourite toys and then tracing back in time to favourite toys of long ago.

In DT, we will be preparing our favourite fruits and vegetables to make a fruit salad.

In ICT we will be using technology to take photos of ourselves and using these to create art work. We will look at algorithms.

In English we will be writing lists, labels and captions. We will read and write poems about our senses and will look at stories with familiar settings. We will read *Peace at Last* and *Dogger* and use these to create our own stories.

In art we will be looking at the work of Keith Haring and Picasso and will be creating our own art in the style of these artists using clay and pastels. We will practise our observational pencil drawing and will be printing using fruit and vegetables.

In music we will be singing lots of action songs to do with our bodies. We will use our bodies as musical instruments to perform and compose together.
