

Medium Term Plan - Year 3 Spring Term

Non-Topic Overview

RE - Jesus as an inspiration.

Maths - fractions of numbers and shapes and measures (including time, length, capacity and weight)

PE - hockey and swimming

British Values -linked to Romans and Roman Britain

In English this term we will read the book 'The Roman Beanfeast' by Gillian Cross. We will ask and answer questions about the book and use it as a stimulus to write in character role. We will also create personification poetry and design leaflets for visitors to the Roman York.

In science we will study the skeleton in order to name the bones in the body, we will also discover how the muscles in our bodies work. We will link this to the discoveries of Leonardo da Vinci and we will also discover how shadows are formed and change.

What did the Romans do for us?

In ICT we will use a variety of software to collect, analyse, evaluate and present data and information responsibly and safely by making a leaflet about York.

In design and technology we will use textiles to build a 2D to 3D project in weaving. We will look at the process from shearing to cloth and make our own woven pictures.

In geography we will look at the human and physical features in Britain and Italy. We will look at the impact that the Romans had on roads and places.

In art we will study the work of the Italian greats, eg: Michaelangelo and Leonardo da Vinci, before trying to replicate one of their paintings using pastels and watercolours.

In history we will study the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain - including the legacy and influence on our lives today. We will consider then impact on language, food, homes and numbers.

We will design our own mosaics having studied Roman designs.
