EYFS – welcome to all our new children and their families! Our main focus has been to ensure that the children are developing relationships with their peers and adults. We hope that they feel safe, secure and confident and that they are enjoying their new environments and learning the daily routines.

Year 1 children have settled really well into their new classes. We have been sorting and counting and have been learning about parts of our body. We have lots of eager learners and have made a good start to our 'This is Me' topic.

Year 2 – In maths, recognising numbers to 100, working with two digit numbers and Counting in 2s,5s and 10s. English writing recounts of summer holidays. Colour mixing and creating shades using black and white.

Year 3 children have settled in well and their teachers are very proud. We have done Treasure Hunts and read 'Oh the places we will go' by Dr Seuss.

What a busy 'buzzing with enthusiasm, exploring new topics and launching into a new year with determination' kind of school!

Year 4 children enjoyed the topic launch on Wednesday. They learned songs and played an Anglo-Saxon version of 'Who wants to be a Millionaire?' We have also started our Beowulf story in English and our place value topic in Maths.

Year 6 had a race to the South Pole for our 'Against All Odds' topic launch. This guided reading based lesson resulted in the team of Edward, Demir and Will raising the Norwegian flag.

Year 5 children have worked really hard following the school values. Pluto have been looking at the features of an explanation text and Asteroid children have found themselves lost in space on the rocket ship 'Infinite Possibility' wondering - has the world as we know it vanished?!
