EYFS children have celebrated 'International Dot Day!' They have had lots of fun taking part in dotty activities including painting, drawing and decorating biscuits.

Year 1 children have been reading 'Owl Babies' and retelling the story. In Science they have investigated whether the taller children have bigger feet. They have also been throwing and catching with balls in PE.

Year 2 children counted in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. They also worked on solving number problems. They made bread and wrote instructions. They created silhouette pictures of London and created fiery lanterns.

Year 3 children looked at different artists' impressions of volcanoes and produced their own gallery of volcano art. Mrs Keel was very impressed with how sensible Jupiter were with the paints and Mrs Stubbs feels that this week, Saturn have demonstrated the very essence of respect.

What a busy 'volcanic, Titanic, artistic and dot-tastic' kind of week!

Year 4 – children have had another fabulous week. They have written a letter to a friend to describe how the characters felt during a fight between Beowulf and Grendel's mother. They have also been learning about how to build tension in stories.

Year 6 children have been busy learning about the Titanic. They have started a class novel, have written adverts for the 'unsinkable' ship and have looked at the Liner's numerical data. They have also completed some 'Southern Lights' artwork using different media to create perspective.

Year 5 children have been reading 'The Way Back Home' by Oliver Jeffers, attempting a piece of dialogue writing, using imaginative description and characterisation. In maths the children have looked at negative numbers and reading temperature graphs.
