## NEWSLETTER Week 5 5<sup>th</sup> October 2018

### This Week

**EYFS** children have had a fantastic week continuing their Autumn theme. They have learned about hibernation, migration and nocturnal animals. Clay hedgehogs have been made. Chocolate apples and hot chocolate have been on offer!

**Year 1** children have been reading, sequencing and writing 'Peace at Last.' In maths they have ordered amounts and numbers. They have been using their senses of sight, smell and touch to do lots of activities including drawing self-portraits.

**Year 2** children interviewed the real live Samuel Pepys. Funnily enough, he looked just like the Y6 Nebular teacher - Mr Close! In Science they tested materials to see which could squash, twist, bend and stretch.

**Year 3** children have experienced what life was like in Pompeii at the time of Vesuvius erupting 79AD. They used lots of descriptive language, erupting household chemicals and a range of art activities. They have also enjoyed starting to learn French, practising greetings with enthusiasm. **What a busy 'from France to Italy then on to the moon and back' kind of week!**

**Year 4** – children have been great all week. They have been learning about persuasive advert features and have started to think about what language they could use to help sell their friend as an Anglo-Saxon slave!

**Year 6** in maths the children have worked on division and remainders. They have continued their voyage on the Titanic and have started to write a newspaper report about its sinking, including the use of direct and reported speech. They have also studied the Science behind sight and light. Ask the children about green tables!

**Year 5** children have been investigating the moon – its surface and the lunar phases. They have also been editing and redrafting their story writing and solving problems based on the subtraction of four digit numbers. New Y5 monitors have been helping with KS1 lunches and watching for clean plates to give out stickers.
