Dear Parent/Carers,

A warm welcome to the new year school in year 5, at Brayton Primary School. The year 5 team are very excited, not only with the prospect of teaching the topics we are covering this year, but also to have your children within our year group. You will find attached, the 'Into the Unknown' topic coverage, which gives a brief look at the Space themed curriculum that will be taught in the Autumn term.
